BMMD streets department performs road maintenance, snow plowing, storm sewer collections, and drainage services for the Wildernest community. This is an excellent opportunity for a self-motivated, hardworking, and dedicated individual to work in the mountains. This position will be responsible for a variety of duties and for operating a variety of heavy machinery and equipment to maintain our district. This is a full-time position with a competitive pay and benefits package.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

<u>Summer (May-Sept)</u> In the beautiful summer months, this position works on a variety of tasks based on current conditions and needs

- Perform minor asphalt pothole repairs and filling cracks
- · Mow grass and maintain weeds along roadways and district facilities
- Inspect roadway and driveway culverts and clean as needed
- Remove debris from roadways including rocks, mud, trees, trash, etc.
- Mechanical street sweeping of roads and pedestrian path
- Maintain storm sewer infrastructure and drainage ditches. Including vegetation control, grading and sloping, creating and maintaining sediment basins.
- Maintain road shoulders
- Maintain dog waste stations

<u>Winter (Oct – April)</u> During the snowy winter season this position focuses on snowplowing and snow removal in the district

- Snow plowing/removal and deicing on public roads in the district
- · Perform "pushbacks" as needed
- · Maintain district facilities access

Year Round

- Install and repair roadway delineators
- Maintain and replace street signage
- Minor guardrail repairs

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. Graduation from an accredited High School or GED
- 2. Two (2) years experience working with heavy equipment
- 3. Streets maintenance, utility, construction experience preferred
- 4. Experience with equipment such as front-end loaders, backhoes, skidsteers, dump trucks, hand tools, etc.
- 5. Reliable transportation and housing in or near Summit County. (See housing information below)
- 6. Must have a valid license
- 7. Ability to work outside in our high alpine environment

RESPONSIBILITIES

- This position operates a variety of tools, machinery, and equipment
- Perform routine maintenance and inspections of equipment to ensure proper functioning. Including

greasing of equipment, cutting-edge repairs, tire chains, etc. Report issues and deficiencies

- Follow safety protocols and guidance to maintain a safe working environment
- Works as a certified flagger when needed
- Maintain courteous working relationships with supervisors, coworkers, contractors, and the public
- Assists other district departments and agencies as needed and directed
- Be able to perform manual tasks such as lifting up to 80lbs, more with assistance. Be able to climb stairs, crouch, kneel, stoop, and walk on uneven ground at times.
- Must be able to deal with stressful situations as they arise
- Work independently and as part of a team
- Identify and relay any covenant violation to the district administration
- Adhere to all traffic laws, regulations, and company policies while operating vehicles on public roads and job sites

JOB DETAILS

- Summer Hours (May-Sept) are 8:00 a.m.–5:00 p.m., Monday-Friday (5/8hr days), 30 min lunch (40-hour week). Staff rotates on-call coverages for road/drainage emergencies
- Winter Hours (Oct-April) are 4:00 a.m.–12:00 p.m., Days vary depending on shift (4/10hr days), 30 min lunch (40-hour week). Staff rotates on-call coverages for snow removal and road/drainage emergencies
- Additional Hours will be required to work overtime, weekends, and holidays and also for callouts.
- Overtime will be offered in exchange for hours worked outside the scope of regular business hours
- BMMD is a drug-free workplace
- Start Date is July 1^{st,} 2024
- Pay frequency is bi-weekly
- This position reports to the Streets Foreman and is located at 102 Adams Ave, Silverthorne, CO
